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A NOTE ON KIMERU

Kimeru is the language of the Meru, a Bantu ethnic group living on Mount Kenya's agriculturally rich northeastern slopes in the Eastern Province of Kenya. Most are agrarian. The Meru form a fairly homogeneous linguistic group: while there are some regional variations, all the sub-groups understand each other well. As a whole, Kimeru exhibits older Bantu characteristics in grammar and phonetic forms than its neighbouring languages. Even so, it bears a close resemblance to the Bantu languages of the Kikuyu, Embu and Kamba. To the West, Kimeru borders Cushitic languages. The Meru of Tanzania speaks a Bantu language slightly different from the Kenyan Meru. About 2.5 million people currently speak Kimeru.

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
